




# Information Sheet for (Mountain) Catering and Apres Ski

The 2020/21 winter season presents us all with very particular challenges. Together we are doing everything possible to nevertheless make this winter into a success and to enable our guests to have a safe and relaxing winter holiday.

## AUSTRIANWIDE MEASURES

The following measures have been implemented by the Austrian Federal Government, based on the current [statutory regulations](#):

- A maximum of ten people (plus children) per group of visitors
- Nationwide: opening times are from 5 am and closing times to 1 am the next day. **PLEASE NOTE:** in the province of Salzburg the rules are more restrictive. Closing times throughout the province have been brought forward to 10 pm
- Food and drink should not be consumed in the direct vicinity of the serving area
- Consumption of food and drink both inside and outside may occur only when seated
- A minimum distance of 1 metre between serving places and between people from different groups of visitors
- Compulsory face coverings for staff and guests indoors – apart from when guests are seated at their place
- Compulsory prevention/hygiene plan for venues with a capacity of more than 200



## COVID-BOARD SALZBURGERLAND RECOMMENDATIONS

For optimal preparation for the coming winter, in addition to putting the above-named safeguards in place, the Covid-Board Salzburgerland also recommends implementing the following measures:

### General

- Controlling admission to limit the number of guests
- Displaying clearly visible information on boards, signs, posts, floor markings or other aids and ensuring that these can be seen as soon as the guest enters the establishment
- Informing guests of peak times
- Ensuring background music is played only at a low volume
- Taking special cleaning measures and regularly ventilating the premises

### Set-up of the guest room and serving of food and drink

- Food and drink should not be consumed in the direct vicinity of the serving area
- Table surfaces, backs of chairs and arm rests should be cleaned between each guest and the tablecloth should also be changed
- Buffets are permitted as long as specific hygiene precautions have been taken to minimise the risk of infections (for example, disposable gloves, sanitiser points etc)

### Après Ski und Schirmbars

- These won't exist in a traditional sense – instead the focus will be on gastronomy (food and drink without dancing and loud music)
- Dance floors will be transformed into seating areas
- Current hospitality-industry regulations should be applied
