



# Information Sheet for Hotels and Other Accommodation

The 2020/21 winter season presents us all with very particular challenges. Together we are doing everything possible to nevertheless make this winter into a success and to enable our guests to have a safe and relaxing winter holiday.

## AUSTRIANWIDE MEASURES

The following measures have been implemented by the Austrian Federal Government, based on the current [statutory regulations](#):

- A minimum distance of 1 metre between guests from others who are not in the same group of guests
- Mandatory face coverings for personnel with customer contact and for guests when entering indoor public spaces
- A distance of 1.5 metres in shared dormitories between people who don't live in the same household



## COVID-BOARD SALZBURGERLAND RECOMMENDATIONS

For optimal preparation for the coming winter, in addition to putting the above-named safeguards in place, the Covid-Board SalzburgerLand also recommends implementing the following measures:

### Prävention

- Proactively educating and cultivating awareness amongst employees
- Drafting an inhouse Covid-19 emergency plan
- Checklists for prevention of Covid-19 in accommodation facilities

### Testing



Precaution: all accommodation facilities are urgently recommended to have their employees tested regularly



Costs are currently borne by the Austrian Federal Government



Compulsory testing for both domestic and foreign seasonal workers before starting work and taking up residence of their living quarters. All information about the current testing offers [can be found here](#) (German only).

### Quarantine

- It is optimal for infected guests to make their own way home if they have travelled with their own car and it's possible for them to depart in an unproblematic fashion (all borders are open, etc)
- There are already designated quarantine zones in SalzburgerLand. If necessary, call 1450, the Austrian Health Advice hotline
- Alternative: quarantine in your own hotel

### Youth Hostels

- A school class is considered a family group
- Multi-bed rooms in youth hostels are not considered to be communal shared rooms and dormitories
- Test recommendations: school classes should be tested before arrival and departure
- A Covid representative should be appointed and trained in each youth hostel
